W.E.D. Beach Clean, Saturday 7th June, Perranporth, 11am

We shall be performing a beach clean for *World Environment Day*, meeting at Perranporth Beach Car Park at 11am on 7th June (charges apply at the car park). We will stroll across the dunes to the *Lost Church of St Piran*, then clean back along Perranporth Beach. Bags and gloves shall be provided. At 1pm there is a 1-hour beach training session (it is not compulsory to take part and club or white suits may be worn - you may also want to bring a towel but do not have to go in the sea if you don't want to), followed by lunch at the *Watering Hole* at 2pm. Please bring your family and friends (you may also bring your dogs!). General Choi Hong Hi stipulated that Tae Kwon-Do training should involve community service so this event is a worthwhile way to support your local community, the local environment and your Tae Kwon-Do school.

Coloured Belt Grading

The next coloured belt grading will be held at Pool School, Camborne on Monday 16th June at 7pm. Students must:

1. Submit their licences and grading fees (£22) by Monday 18th Feb (new students will also need to supply 2 passport photos)
2. Arrive at the grading by no later than 6.30pm
3. Ensure that they address Master Harrison as 'Sir' at all times
4. Ensure that they know their theory (manuals available from Instructors) (theory sheets are online at: www.truro-taekwondo.com/grading.aspx)
5. Ensure that they wear a clean, white GTI dobok (no jewellery!)
6. Bring a headguard/sparring gear if green belt or above (compulsory)

If you are unsure about anything to do with your grading please speak to your Instructor. For those that cannot make the Camborne grading there is another grading in Newquay on Weds 18th. Please note that the parents/guardians of all under-18s will need to sign the grading cards. Good luck to all students grading and remember to be loud and respectful!
